RABBI SOLOMON B. FREEHOF is an alumnus of the Hebrew Union College, ordained in 1915. During the First World War he was a chaplain in the American Expeditionary Force. After his ordination he continued as a member of the faculty of his alma mater; in 1924 he became rabbi of Kehillath Anshe Maariv Temple in Chicago; and in 1934 he became rabbi of Rodef Shalom Temple in Pittsburgh, of which he is now Rabbi Emeritus.
